Overall Purpose:

To be responsible for the competition opportunities for the athletes within the club, including championships, leagues, open graded meets and any other highlighted event that is deemed beneficial to the clubs athletes.

Members should include all current team managers (leagues, relays, cross country, road running) plus an athlete's representative

Areas of Responsibility

- Recruitment of team managers for all leagues, currently they are:
 - Youth Development League Upper
 - Youth Development League Lower
 - Scottish Men's League
 - Scottish Women's League
 - Forth Valley League
 - Scottish Indoor League
 - East District Cross Country League
- Organising officials for all leagues (leagues listed above)
- Payment of fees for all leagues (leagues listed above)
- Recruitment of team managers for the following relay championships
 - Scottish Age Group Outdoor and Indoor
 - Under 13s, 15s, 17s
 - Scottish Senior and under 20 Outdoor and Indoor
 - East District Cross Country Relay Championships
 - Scottish Cross Country Relay Championships
 - Scottish Road Relay Championships
- Payment of all relay team entries to championships (as listed above)
- Recruitment of team manager for super teams outdoor and indoor
- Responsible for any team selection disputes
- Liaise with team selections to ensure the same athletes are not being overused
- Raise any concerns for area of weakness with executive and coaching sub group
- Identify transport requirements to club competitions where required
 - Identify costs for the season
 - Identify reasons for any transport hiring
 - Liaise with the fundraising sub group to assist with raising any monies
- Promote athlete participation and liaise with athletes and coaches where required to ensure all athletes get an opportunity to compete.

Sub Group Definition

- This may include identifying races like Open Graded Meets for athletes
- Liaise with athletes and coaches to ensure a large number of athletes are entering the Scottish Championships
 - Age group Outdoor and Indoor
 - Senior Outdoor and Indoor
 - Combined Events Outdoor and Indoor
 - Scottish East/West/North District Outdoor Championships
 - National Open Indoor
 - East District Cross Country
 - Scottish Cross Country
- Payment of fees for the entries for the East District and Scottish Cross Country Championships (Athletes do cover their own payment this has to be submitted per club and not individually)
- Review current club competition structure annually to ensure it is the correct athlete requirement for the following season
- Identify higher level competition for the clubs senior athletes to ensure appropriate competition opportunities above the current leagues
 - This may require races in the rest of the UK, Europe or further afield
 - This may require working with race promoters to get the athletes onto the start lists
- Attend all AGMs for each league the club participate in
- Share key successes via the communications/promotions sub group to ensure maximum exposure
- Work on more cross club activity to involve all competitive members, e.g. road running and Track & Field competing more together
- Monthly report to the Pitreavie Executive

Additional Information:

- Youth Development League Upper Details:
 - Pitreavie compete as part of a composite team called Kingdom Athletic. This team comprises athlete from Dundee Hawkhill Harriers and Fife AC as well as Pitreavie AAC. The team manager therefore needs to work with their counterparts from the other two clubs. Agreement between the three parties is therefore required as to who the lead team manager is for the season.
 - Kingdom Athletic have their own small committee that the Pitreavie Team manager would automatically become part of.
 - All payments for this league are handled by the Kingdom Athletic Treasurer so payments from Pitreavie AAC are passed onto the Kingdom Athletic Treasurer.
- The AGM for the YDL Upper and Lower is normally held in Birmingham. The Pitreavie AAC Upper Team Manager can represent and hold the vote for the Pitreavie AAC Lower with another member of the Kingdom Athletic committee holding the Kingdom Athletic vote.
